

How to Prepare the Household Packaging Report for the First Time?

Key Concepts

Household packaging refers to packaging for products intended for personal use or consumption, regardless of whether the packaging is primary, secondary, or tertiary, as long as it can be purchased by consumers in stores, regardless of the place of sale or consumption.

Examples of household packaging include:

Primary packaging:

- Plastic bottles for water, soft drinks, or milk.
- Tetra Paks for juice or milk.
- Cans for food, beverages, or domestic aerosols.
- Cardboard boxes for cereals or cookies.
- Packaging for cosmetic products (creams, shampoos, etc.).

Secondary (grouping) packaging:

- Packs of soda cans wrapped in shrink plastic.
- Cardboard trays for grouping bottles.

Tertiary packaging (if it reaches the consumer):

- Cardboard boxes used for home deliveries if they reach the final consumer.

Service packaging:

- Shopping bags given to the consumer.
- Disposable cups for beverages.
- Trays or packaging for fresh food.
- All of these must be included in the report.

Sources of information

- If your company has previously reported to the Producer Register We recommend retrieving the most recent data from the Register to use as a baseline. Update this information with the sales data for 2024, ensuring all the packaging types are accounted for.
- If your company has not yet reported to the EPR: You will need to create an inventory of the packaging placed on the market as described above. This includes type, material, average weight, and units sold in 2024. You can download the declaration Excel sheet from the [Producers portal](#).

For reusable packaging, additional information will be required. More details can be found at this [link](#).

Once you have gathered this information, you can complete the Procircular declaration Excel sheet. For the 2025 packaging report, sales data for 2024 relating to products marketed in the national market will be used.
